



Team Competition

Summary

A team competition will operate during the road race season. Team members will earn points during the season, based upon finishing position in designated races. The team accumulating the most points during the season will win the team competition.

Points may be scored by riders in participating in any of the senior categories, A, B, C & Women, but will generally be weighted towards higher categories.

Team member designation

Teams wishing to be considered for the team competition must submit a list of team members to the Team Competition Coordinator prior to the start of the first race of the season. No rider will score points for a team unless he/she has been designated as a team member. Teams may add team members by notification in writing to the Team Competition Coordinator prior to the start of any race.

There is no limit to the number of riders that a team may designate as team members.

Riders may switch teams during the season, subject to notification in writing as noted above, but any points earned by a rider changing teams are not transferable to the new team.

Team riders must ride in team uniform during races.

Qualifying races

The following races will be included in the season competition:

- Road race points series races
- Time trial series races

Points awards

Points are to be awarded for finishing places in accordance with the following scheme:
